## Farm Cash Receipts, January - June 2004

Statistics Canada estimates January-June (Q2) 2004 **Saskatchewan** farm cash receipts at \$3.04 billion, up 8.6% or \$240 million from Q2-2003.

Crop receipts increased 45.4% to \$1.8 billion, with increases for wheat, barley, and canola.

Livestock revenues decreased 11.2% to \$650 million with 19.1% decrease in cattle and 5.3% decrease in calves.

Program payments during Q2-2004 decreased 30.9% to \$559 million, compared to Q2-2003.

Q2-2004 **Canada** farm cash receipts were \$17.9 billion, up 6.3% from \$16.8 billion in Q2-2003.

**Canada's** crop receipts increased 21.7% to \$7.4 billion:

- Wheat, barley and canola production increased about 60% in 2003 compared to drought levels in 2002.
- Crop deliveries increased during Q2-2004 compared to Q2-2003.
- Canadian Wheat Board (CWB) payments for wheat and barley increased for Q2-2004 compared to Q2-2003.
- Canola deliveries doubled during Q2-2004 compared to Q2-2003, and prices increased steadily in 2004.

Livestock receipts in **Canada** decreased 5.6% to \$8.1 billion during Q2-2004, compared to Q2-2003:

- Cattle and calf receipts decreased 24.5% to \$2.4 billion in Q2-2004 as both marketings and prices dropped due to the ban on cattle and beef exports.

**Canadian** program payments during Q2-2004 were up 10.8%, at \$2.3 billion, from Q2-2003:

- Withdrawal of \$703 million from NISA accounts in Q2-2004 was double compared to Q2-2003.
- Payments from income disaster assistance programs were \$231 million in Q2-2004, up 23.5%, compared to Q2-2003.
